

WEAVE DRAWING

ADVANCED ART/ADVANCED ART HONORS

MATERIALS

Complementary/Contrasting Images (roughly the same size/scale)

18 by 24 White Drawing Paper

Drawing Pencils, Colored Pencils

Tape

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Select a theme that is of interest/importance to you. Look for images that contrast in value. Ideally they should be the same size.
2. Cut the first image into 1" strips, keeping them together at the top.
3. Cut the second image horizontally in 1" strips.
4. Tape the vertically cut set of strips down onto a surface. Weave the horizontal strips over-under, over under. Take a GOOD look at the squares that you can see. Do you want to change the basic weave? You can eliminate squares that you do not want to see. Once the woven images are set the way you want them...tape them securely.
5. Lightly draw a larger grid on the white drawing paper. Check with the teacher to make sure you have selected the correct grid size on the larger paper.
6. Transfer the combined images onto the larger grid. Use a range of values to develop the graphite pencil portion of the drawing. Use colored pencils to develop the other image.
7. Work carefully, focusing on one square at a time.

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
